2-1 External projections

Summary of legislation

Applicable legislation

- Land Transport Rule: External Projections 2001

Compliance with approved standards

- A vehicle of class MA, MB, MC, MD1 or NA manufactured on or after 1 March 1998 must comply with one or more of the approved external projection standards in **Table 2-1-1**.

Condition, performance and modification

- External projections must comply with the requirements relating to condition, performance and modification set out in the *VIRM: In-service certification*, section 2-1.

Reasons for rejection

Compliance with approved standards

- A vehicle of class MA, MB, MC, MD1 or NA manufactured on or after 1 March 1998 did not comply, or cannot be demonstrated to have complied, with all the standard(s) listed in at least one of the four columns in **Table 2-1-1** at the time the vehicle was manufactured.

Condition, performance and modification

- An external projection does not comply with a requirement relating to condition, performance or modification set out in the *VIRM: In-service certification*, section 2-1.

Note 1 If a vehicle is fitted with an auxiliary bar (eg a bullbar), refer to Technical bulletin 6 – Auxiliary bars.

* A vehicle of class MA, MB, MC, MD1 or NA manufactured on or after 1 March 1998 must comply with the standard(s) listed in at least one of the four columns.

Vehicles must comply with the requirements relating to mandatory equipment set out in the *VIRM: In-service certification*, section 2-2.

There are no additional requirements in respect of dimensions for the inspection and certification of vehicles for entry into service.
