



# Private Hire Service Registration

Section 6.1(7) of the *Land Transport Rule Operator Licensing 2007* requires any person who operates a private hire service to register their service with the NZ Transport Agency before commencing the service. Existing operators must also register. In addition, a copy of the signed acknowledgement must be carried by the driver in the service as evidence of this registration and made available to an enforcement officer on demand.

**Privacy notice** The information collected in this form will be used to update the Transport Service Licence (TSL) Register maintained by the NZ Transport Agency. The information collected and stored on the TSL Register is used by the NZ Transport Agency and the New Zealand Police to administer the various laws that apply to transport service operators, including the Land Transport Act 1998 and any amendments. The information is kept for as long as necessary to achieve the purposes of collection. The Privacy Act 1993 states that information held on the TSL Register is automatically available to the New Zealand Police. The Land Transport Act 1998 states that the TSL Register is a public register that can be searched by any member of the public. The information may also be subject to requests under the Privacy Act 1993 and the Official Information Act 1982. Any such requests are dealt with under the legislation current at the time of the request. If the information collected is personal information in terms of the Privacy Act 1993, you may request access to and correction of that information.
