Approved trials of traffic control devices – information

Under *subclause 3.4(1)* of the *Land Transport Rule: Traffic Control Devices 2004* the Director of Land Transport (Director) may authorise a road controlling authority to install and maintain a traffic control device for trial purposes.

The purpose of this note is to advise of traffic control device (TCD) trials that have been approved by the Director. Attached are brief details of each of the trials (including contact details for further information) and copies of the notices published in the *NZ Gazette* authorising the trials. It is intended any newly approved trials will be appended to this note. As trials are finalised the results and proposals arising will also be outlined.

The Land Transport New Zealand's approval procedures for TCD trials are outlined in Traffic Note 10.
