Railway Level Crossing Guideline Published - Information

The Land Transport Safety Authority (LTSA) has published a guideline document entitled [Road signs and markings for railway level crossings.](#)

It provides a consolidated general reference to the requirements for level crossing controls and treatments. Reference will need to be made to other publications, such as the *Manual of Traffic Signs and Markings*, for details of technical design and placement of the control devices described in the guideline.

The guideline is not prescriptive except where particular requirements are deemed mandatory and are noted as such in the text. The LTSA, however, recommends that this guideline and its referenced publications be adhered to.
